During this term, we will revise the areas of maths that we have visited over Autumn term and start to learn about measurement.

- Place value (within 20 and 50)
- Addition and subtraction
- Length and height
- Mass and volume

How you can help:

- continue to practise adding and subtracting
- practising naming the months of the year and days of the week in order
- counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- going over the spellings for the numbers one to fifty.
- practise finding one and ten more or less than a number within 100.

We will also be learning about The Great Fire of London, the key events of the fire, what London was like at the time of the fire, including features and types of buildings, making comparisons and sequencing events in chronological order.

Computing:

Y1 will be learning about programming, using Bee-Bots and online safety.

Wellbeing

We will continue with our weekly wellbeing tasks and PHSE lessons about coping with different emotions using the zones of regulation. We will also learn about safety and what to do in an emergency.

Music:

We will be learning about dynamics and sound patterns through the themes of '**The Seaside**' and '**Fairytales**'.

Science:

Y1 will be learning about seasonal changes. This will include looking at the growth and development of animals and plants and changes in the weather.

Geography:

The children will be learning about the United Kingdom, the city of London, its famous landmarks and comparing it to another international capital city. They will name and describe the purpose of human features and landmarks.

English:

Children will be creating their own diary entries and writing stories based in London. They will be writing lists, labels and captions. Children will develop their topic vocabulary and learn how to present information concisely. Children will also be learning how to write a set of directions from one landmark to another.

Y1 will be focussing on building language, vocabulary and grammar. We will continue to work on practising correct letter and number formation.

Phonics and reading:

It is vital for your child to be reading **every day**. The reading planet colour banded books will reinforce children's learning and knowledge of phonics.

Please ensure that their books are in their bags **every day**.

Art and Design Technology:

We will be creating our own motifs and we will be exploring line, shape, texture. We will also be creating 2D models, using different techniques to join and attach materials.
