


Coulsdon Reading Newsletter

They have worked diligently to promote reading for pleasure in our school by setting up and















The Day the Crayons Quit by Oliver Jeffers "The peach crayon has his paper taken off, it's really funny" Chloe



War Horse by Michael Morpurgo "It's got loads of action and it's really interesting." Jack












Here are our Summer Reading recommendations from the Reading ambassadors:


