Year 3 Trip to the Natural History Museum

On Friday 18th July, Year 3 will be visiting the Natural History Museum in South Kensington to take part in a Lego building workshop – "Build the Change: Save our Planet" and to watch an interactive show entitled "Emergency! Earthquakes and Volcanoes".

We will be travelling to and from London using public transport, taking the train from Coulsdon South Station to London, then changing to take the tube to South Kensington. The museum is a short walk from there.

We will be leaving school after morning registration and are expecting to arrive back at school at approximately 3.30pm. Depending on the time we arrive back and the weather, we may take the bus from the Coulsdon South up to the school. We will notify you by text if we have been delayed.

We will be taking packed lunches with us which will have been prepared by the school caterers, and the children will order their fillings in advance. Children should wear full, smart school uniform and bring a waterproof coat. They will also need a small, named rucksack-type bag to carry their water bottle and packed lunch.

We are very grateful to the Friends Committee who have allocated an amount of money to each class for school trips and activities. The cost of the trip will be covered by this and there is no charge for parents.
