## Year 5 Trip to the Tower of London

On Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November, Year 5 will be visiting the Tower of London as part of our "Crime and Punishment" topic. During our visit, the children will be taking part in a workshop in which they will discover what it was like to be a prisoner in the Tower of London and they will help to plot a prisoner's escape! We will also have some free time to explore the galleries and exhibitions ourselves.

We will be travelling to and from London using public transport, taking the train from Coulsdon South Station to London Bridge, then walking to the Tower of London. The return journey will follow the same route and we will be back in time for the end of the school day. We will be taking packed lunches with us which will have been prepared by the school caterers, and the children will order their fillings in advance. Children should wear full, smart school uniform and bring a waterproof coat. They will also need a small, named rucksack-type bag to carry their water bottle and packed lunch.

The cost of the trip is £7.80 and this amount should be paid on ParentPay in the usual way. Please also give your child consent to take part in this trip by completing the Google form.
